Code of Conduct Policy
2023**

It is the goal of Hartland Baseball to provide a safe, fun and enjoyable environment for our children to learn and play baseball. It shall be the primary objective of every Board Member, Coach, Official and Parent to ensure that this goal is achieved and maintained in our league.

All coaches, parents, and players shall read and sign this Code of Conduct, acknowledging that he/she understands and agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct. Players shall not be permitted to participate in the league until this document is signed and returned to the Hartland Baseball Committee. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure their child understands and complies with the guidelines set forth in this document.

Hartland Baseball / New Hartford Youth Baseball Code of Conduct:

No Board Member, Coach, Player or Spectator shall:

- **Speak disrespectfully to any player, coach, official or representative of the league.**
- At any time, lay a hand upon, push, shove, strike, or threaten to strike an official.
- Be guilty of heaping personal, verbal, or physical abuse upon any official/coach or player for any real or imaginary belief of a wrong decision or judgment.
- Be guilty of an objectionable demonstration of dissent at an official's decision by throwing gloves, helmets, hats, bats, balls, or any other unsportsmanlike action.
- Be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of a game against the body of an opposing player.
- Be guilty of a physical attack upon any board member, official, coach, player or spectator.
- Be guilty of the use of profane, obscene or vulgar language in any manner at any time.
- Appear on the field of play, stands, or anywhere on the Hartland Baseball / NHYB complex while in an intoxicated state at any time. Intoxicated will be defined as a substance odor or behavior issue.
- Be guilty of gambling upon any play or outcome of any game with anyone at any time.
- Smoke while in the stands or on the playing field or in any dugout at any time. Smoking will only be permitted in designated areas, which will be out of view from any spectator stands or dugouts.
- Be guilty of discussing publicly with spectators in a derogatory or abusive manner any play, decision or a personal opinion on any players during the game.
- Be guilty of tampering or manipulation of any league rosters, schedules, draft positions or selections, official score books, rankings, financial records or procedures.
- Challenge an umpire's authority. The umpires shall have the authority and discretion during a game to penalize the offender according to the infraction up to and including removal from the game.
- Challenge an umpire's judgment call.

Any inappropriate behavior by a spectator may be cause for the suspension of a game by the Umpire. Game suspension may continue until such time as the spectator leaves the park.

The Board of Directors will review all infractions of the Hartland Baseball / NHYB Code of Conduct. Depending on the seriousness or frequency, the board may assess additional disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the league.
